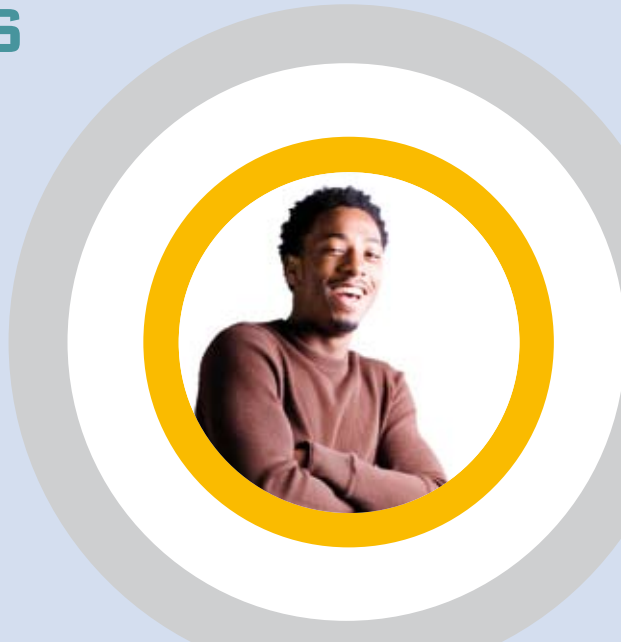

These developments - such as Cabot Circus (the city centre expansion) and Temple Quarter - provide a wide range of exciting training and employment opportunities for local people.

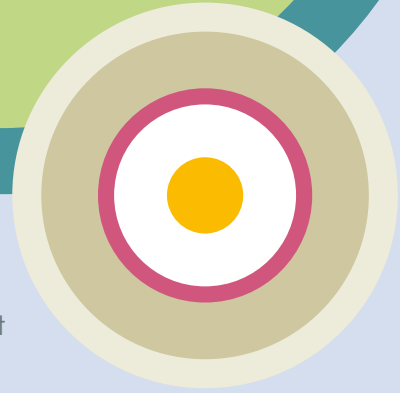
However, it is important that the people of Bristol have the training and the skills that are needed to secure jobs at these new development sites.

West at Work can help

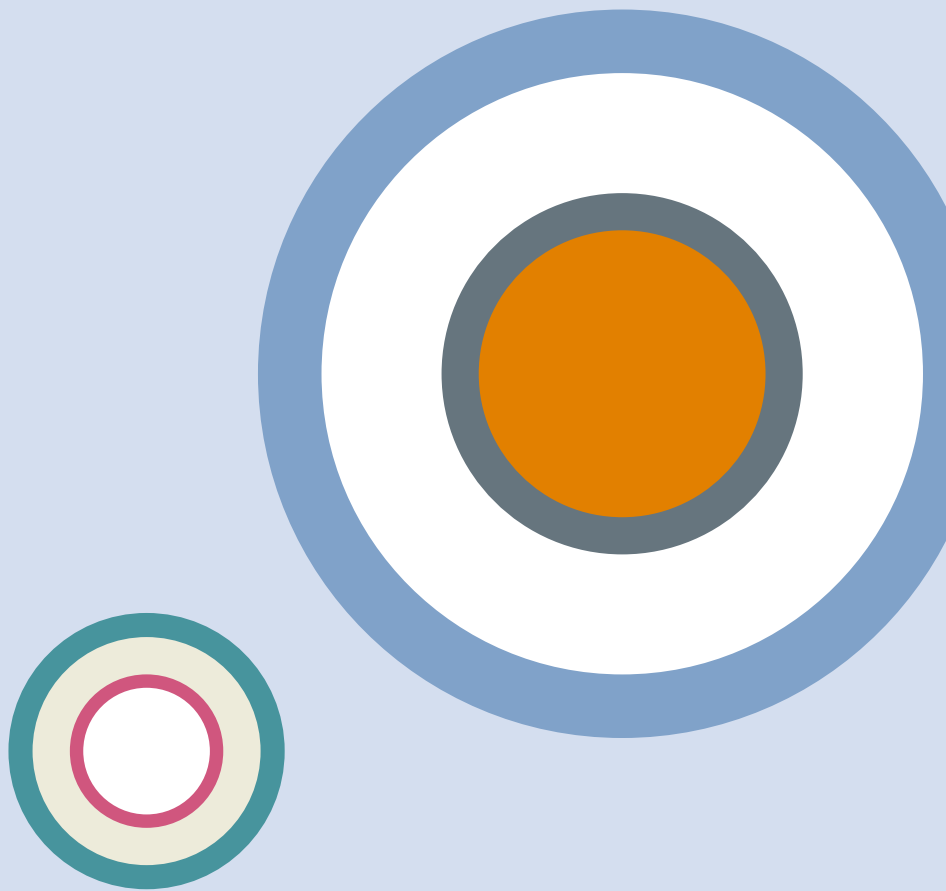
Working with employers, colleges and local groups, West at Work is a partnership project that aims to make sure that people can access local jobs and training, meeting the demand for particular skills, both now and in the future.

Many new jobs will be created by the Cabot Circus development alone, creating a large number of new employment opportunities in key areas such as retail, hospitality, catering and tourism. West at Work wants to make sure that local people are well placed to benefit from all the opportunities on offer.

There will be a particular focus on supporting neighbourhood renewal areas and a number of activities will take place such as training and advice sessions. These activities will start in spring 2007 and more detailed information about these sessions and visits will be available over the coming months.



West at Work also aims to make sure that developers, employers and key agencies understand both the potential and specific requirements of local communities so that particular circumstances or issues can be addressed. Through this approach it is hoped that the developments that are taking place will benefit a variety of people across the city.
